A gold, opal and rose cut diamond ring, mounted with a row of graduated oval opals and four pairs of rose cut diamonds at intervals, the mount with scroll pierced sides, ring size approx L1/2, with an associated box.

Condition Report

229. Overall good condition with no significant damage or repair. Typical light surface wear/abrasions visible under magnification. Opals are a nice vibrant colour with attractive green and pink play to the colour. Mount in fair condition with some surface scratches and wear. Largest opal is approx 0.65cm x 0.5cm. The ring mount is unmarked but looks to be between 15ct and 18ct. There is a lower grade panel band on the inside of the shank which obscures any possible marks and has obviously been added to re-size the ring. Suggested age circa 1900. Weight 5.4g.
