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A pair of Victorian 15ct gold and diamond pendant earrings, each rectangular surmount set with three circular cut diamonds above a circular cluster, set with rose cut diamonds, with post and butterfly fittings, length 2cm, with a case.

Estimate: £300 - £500

Condition Report

263. The cluster drops are probably in association with the three stone surmounts. The rose diamonds to the drops are variously cut, some of these have numerous internal inclusions. The three stone diamond tops have a few internal inclusions, some of which are breaking the surfaces of the stones. The edges of the drops are showing signs of previous work. These earrings have been reconstructed. Weight 3g. Diamond colour approx H-I; Clarity approx I1-I2; total diamond weight approx 0.90ct.

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
