

## **LOT 290**

A gold and diamond cluster ring, claw set with an oval cut diamond within a surround of twelve circular cut diamonds between pierced sides, ring size approx R, with a case.

Estimate: £300 - £500

## **Condition Report**

290. The principal Old European oval cut diamond slightly draws colour and has two or three gletz inclusions near to the surface of the diamond. There is a chip to the diamond between claws and one or two nibbles to the girdle of the diamond. The surrounding circular brilliant cut diamonds have a few internal inclusions. The shank is indistinctly detailed '18ct'. The ring is otherwise in fairly good condition. Weight 4.1g. Colour approx K-L; Clarity approx SI2-I1; principal diamond approx 0.60-0.70ct.

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
