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A Victorian gold, turquoise and diamond demi-parure, each piece with an oval turquoise within a surround of circular cut diamonds, comprising a pendant, length 3cm, a ring, ring size approx L1/2, and a pair of earrings with loop shaped fittings, length 3.7cm.

Estimate: £150 - £250

Condition Report

324. Pendant: the metal work is rather crude. The diamonds draw colour and have numerous internal inclusions. The turquoise is perhaps a replacement. The top fittings of the pendant and the earrings look to be in association with the drops.

Earrings: the diamonds have a few internal inclusions. There is an old crack running across the surface of one of the turquoise.

Ring: the diamonds have a few internal inclusions and are fairly cloudy stones. The ring shank which is unmarked is later. The four oval panels of these three pieces could originally have been the drops from a necklace, later converted.

Total weight 19g.

These pieces are unmarked, but have tested as approx 9ct.

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
