An early 20th century Chinese silver circular footed bowl, the body decorated in relief with prunus and butterflies, 'PK' maker's mark to base, diameter 18.5cm, together with a small group of Chinese silver condiments and a plated napkin ring.

Estimate: £100 - £150

Condition Report

71. Weight of bowl - 608.6g

The rest - 212.7g.

Total weight - 821.3g.

Bowl - generally good condition but would benefit from a clean. Small dents to footrim and typical scratches and surface wear. Gilt interior worn and scratched. Mark to base with maker 'PK'. Weight 608.6g.

Hexagonal dish - minor misshaping and wear, marked to base. Weight 25.4g.

Pair of oval dishes - good condition but dirty. Weight 44.7g. Marked to bases.

Pair of peppers - numerous dents. Weight 52.4g. Marked to bases.

Two-handled pot - some small dents and dirty. Weight 26.5g. Marked to base.

Pair of pierced circular dishes - misshapen rims and some wear. Not marked. Weight 39.3g.

Napkin ring - badly misshapen and tear to rim. Weight 24.4g.
