Condition Report

60. Sovereign and half sovereign case - good condition with only typical light surface scratches. Spring hinge is good and both coin holder springs are good. Hallmarks to interior a bit indistinct/rubbed.

Sovereign case - small dent to hinge lid and back and typical surface scratches. Good clear hallmarks. Spring

hinge and coin holder springs are good.

Pair of wishbone tongs - in good condition. Good clear marks.
