A sixteen page manuscript fragment of Seneca's 'De Ira' on vellum, probably late 15th or early 16th century, $16\text{cm} \times 11.5\text{cm}$, the text in two columns with headings, decorative initials and occasional words in red and blue ink (minor dampstaining and small holes to margins).

Three leaves with marginal holes. Stain to top inner corner of all pages, this occasionally affects the text. Similar stain to first leaf affecting text. Some crinkling and creases to leaves. The pages all have minor age toning.
