### LOT 625

A gold, diamond and half-pearl oval hinged bangle, possibly Indian in the European taste, circa 1900, mounted with five cushion shaped diamonds graduating in size, alternating with graduated half-pearls between half-pearl set sides, on a snap clasp, inside width 5.5cm, total diamond weight approx 0.70ct, fitted with a safety chain.

Estimate: £800 - £1,200

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### Condition Report

625. The principal diamond has a surface reaching black inclusion and other smaller surface reaching inclusions. Most of the remaining diamonds have one or two internal inclusions, though one diamond at one end has two significant surface reaching inclusions. The hinge pin has a few sharp points. The multiple bar construction of the back of the bangle is slightly distorted in places. Cut: old European cut. The florescence of the stones is faint. Colour: approx H-I. Clarity: approx I1-I2. Weight 28.2g.

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
