George Gidley Robinson - 'Wareham Bridge', oil on canvas, signed and dated 1910 recto, titled label verso, $39 \, \text{cm} \times 50 \, \text{cm}$, within a swept gilt composition frame, together with another oil by the same hand, 'A Berkshire Upland'.

Condition Report

118. Wareham Bridge - approx 5cm tear to trunk of tree. Craquelure throughout resulting in some areas of unstable paint and others with small areas of loss of paint. Mould and damp staining, mostly to the bottom half of the picture. Gilt frame with considerable loss to composition and mouldings.

Berkshire Upland - generally in good condition. Some craquelure. Old varnish has discoloured and bloomed in areas. Frame with damage to extremities, particularly corners.
