Smiths - it runs, winds and adjusts smoothly and is in generally good condition. Typical light wear and surface scratches to case. Dial is good.

Monceau - it runs, winds and adjusts smoothly and is in generally good condition. Typical light wear and surface scratches to case. Dial is good.
