LOT 2457

A group of three mid-18th century South Staffordshire enamel oval snuff boxes, each hinged lid with mirror to interior, lengths 4.5cm and 4.8cm (faults), together with two similar cylindrical patch boxes and covers, diameters 2.1cm, and a Viennese enamel cylindrical scent bottle with silver gilt hinged mounts, painted with classical figures and foliate panels within puce borders, length 7cm (faults).

Estimate: £120 - £180

Condition Report

2457 - The box with a portrait on the lid has a crack and some minor loss to the lid.

The 'heart and hand' box has a small crack to one side of the lid, a small chip to the corner of the base and some overall minor cracks to the enamelling.

The other oval box has a badly chipped section to lid and is also chipped around the corner of the base, the interior mirror is cracked.

The small 'Sweets' box has a series of small hairline cracks to the lid. The similar box with dogs on the lid has a chipped rim to the base.

The scent bottle is badly chipped particularly around the corners of the lid and around the corners of the base.
