A Japanese yellow silk embroidered tablecloth, Meiji period, finely worked in coloured threads with a design of a cockerel and a chicken amidst millet and bamboo within a floral border, 143cm x 122cm (faults).

Condition Report

1086. There is some green staining across the upper section of the panel. The silk background has numerous creases. Some wear to silk, particularly around edges with some completely worn-through areas. Otherwise the stitching of the decoration is generally good with vibrant colours. The backing is damaged in places and worn-through, again particularly to edges.
