Condition Report

597. The vari-coloured agates to the band are possibly replacements for woven hair work, which is now lacking. The hallmark looks a little stretched. The rose diamond is drawing colour to grey and has a fracture to the side edge. The black enamel work is a bit rubbed. Weight 2.9g.

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
