A Chinese Canton famille rose porcelain bough pot, early to mid-19th century, of flared square form, finely painted with opposing panels of figural scenes, flanked by a pair of gilt foliate handles, above opposing panels of cockerel and chicken with rocks and flowers and ducks on a lotus pond, all reserved against a gilt ground filled with flowers, fruit and butterflies, height 19cm (lacking pierced cover).

Condition Report

1021. Overall in good condition with no significant damage or repairs but be aware it is missing its cover. There are minor chips to the underside of gilt handles and some typical minor wear to gilt on rim and edges. Enamels are good and vibrant.
