A George III silver oval five-bottle cruet stand with pierced and engraved foliate decoration, fitted with three silver mounted faceted cut glass bottles, London 1792 by William Abdy II, length 15.5cm, together with two similar faceted glass bottles.

Condition Report

306. The stand is in generally good condition, no significant damage or repairs. Typical light wear and surface scratches. Central handle is a bit wobbly but no actual damage. Both glass bottles with pouring lips have damage to silver lips. Three other bottles in good condition with only small chip to base of one. Two of the tops are a bit loose.
