Two silver sovereign cases, one with engraved scroll decoration, Birmingham 1893, the other with hammered decoration, Birmingham 1907, both by Aaron Lufkin Dennison, a silver rectangular vinaigrette, engraved with fruit filled cornucopia and flowers, revealing a pierced hinged grille, Birmingham 1809 by T&C, a sterling vesta case, decorated in relief with a stag, and a rectangular snuff box (faults).

Condition Report

389. Engraved sovereign case - good condition, good clear hallmarks, hinge and spring good.

Other sovereign case has wear to decoration and dented. Hinge good and marks are clear.

Vinaigrette - worn and grille detached. Some dents.

Sterling stag's head vesta - hinge is broken and top detached. Otherwise typical wear and scratches. Plated snuff box - good condition.
