A group of four Chinese blue and white porcelain bowls, Ming/Qing dynasty, comprising one painted with cranes and fruit cluster, diameter 15.2cm, another with two dragons, flaming pearls and vapours, diameter 14.6cm, and two with fruiting vines, diameters 14.6cm and 13cm, together with a small Chinese blue and white circular dish, diameter 10cm (minor faults).

1263. Cranes and Fruit Bowl - Good condition. No significant damage or repairs. Minor rim chips with wear and scratches to interior.

Dragon Bowl - Good condition, minor rim chips and wear to glaze interior.

Larger bowl with Fruiting Vines - Good condition, tiny hairline to rim and wear to interior glaze.

Smaller bowl with Fruiting Vines - Good condition. Minor rim chips and wear to glaze.

Small dish - numerous chips to rim and small star crack to base.
