A Copeland Crystal Palace Art Union Parian bust of William Shakespeare, 1860s, modelled after R. Monti, raised on a socle base, impressed marks to back of bust, height of bust 25cm (detached from base).

### Condition Report

1495. Black pitting to nose. Socle base has been later re-attached with a screw fixing, there are two large and a number of smaller chips/nicks to the edges of the socle, and some associated small chips to the base edge of the bust. Fine vertical haircrack running from left side of collar, down shirt, underneath shoulder to back of bust. Some typical firing cracks which have some filling.
