A pair of Royal Doulton stoneware vases, early 20th century, the high shouldered tapered bodies decorated by Hannah Barlow, monogrammed, with three panels of horses within green stylized foliate framing against a light brown ground, impressed and incised marks to bases, height 19.5cm.

Condition Report

4125. Both vases in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration. One vase has a minor glazed over manufacturing blemish to the foot and both show some typical minor wear/glaze abrasions, primarily to the tubelining but only noticeable on very close inspection.
