A pair of Burmantofts pottery turquoise glazed jardinière stands, late 19th century, of octagonal shape, decorated in relief with vertical panels of stylized flowerheads above stepped bases, impressed marks to interiors with shape number '1422', height 42.5cm (some faults).

Estimate: £40 - £60

Condition Report

4137. Both heavily crazed with extensive wear/scratches to top surfaces and widest parts.

1st - chip along one edge of hexagonal foot, noticeable but not to a massively dramatic effect when on a flat surface due to the flared shape of the foot. 1.5cm x 1cm glaze chip to one vertical panel edge towards base. Some glaze loss to interior noticeable when inverted.

2nd - approx 1.5cm square flat chip to one exterior corner of foot and some very minor spots of glaze loss to stepped section of base.
