A Rolex 9ct gold cased keyless wind open-faced gentleman's pocket watch, the jewelled movement detailed 'Rolex Swiss made, Timed 3 positions for all climates', the indistinctly signed enamelled dial with black Roman numerals and subsidiary seconds, the snap case back presentation inscribed 'Presented to Mr A. Stacey by Woking Co-operative Society Limited on completion of 21 years service March 1932', Birmingham 1930, case diameter 4.8cm, with a case.
