A 19th century brass skeleton timepiece with single fusee movement, the pierced silvered chapter ring with black Roman hour numerals and inscribed 'T. Haycock, Ashbourne', the pierced scrollwork frame raised on turned supports and a rosewood base, height 29.5cm, with pendulum, winding key and glass dome.

Estimate: £400 - £600

Condition Report

1140. Simple timepiece mechanism in a rather dirty condition, although running ok. Dial a little insecure and hands not original. Some wear to pivots and some vice marks to pillars. Base and dome of a later date and dome of moulded construction. Original pendulum but winding key not original.
