Condition Report

2559. No loss to the mosaic, however 'Calverley Hotel' and 'Gibraltar Cottage' both have evidence of woodworm. The hotel has a woodworm trail just left of the building and more visible woodworm to the back, also some light surface cracking. The cottage has a series of four holes bottom left and some resultant surface dust to the panel.
