A Chinese Canton enamel tray, 19th century, of rectangular shape with indented corners, painted with a central famille rose panel of four musicians being watched by a further figure, within a fruiting vine border against a blue trellis ground, decorated with flowers and Buddhistic emblem roundels, 29.5cm x 18.5cm (minor faults).

Estimate: £80 - £120

Condition Report

1010. Footrim misshaped with some enamel loss. Enamel loss to two corners on underside of tray with minor dent to one of these corners which has subsequent enamel loss to the upper surface. Otherwise small areas of enamel loss to upper edges of tray near three of the indented corners. The surface overall is heavily scratched with a possible area of filling to the central panel in the upper right hand corner.
