## LOT 3241

MILITARY. An orders and charges book for Swinley Camp near Windsor, circa 1800, approximately 210pp., leaves 19cm x 11.5cm, relating to the King's Own Infantry, Horse Guards, York Hussars, Brigade of Guards, etc., including details of court martials, exercise and military engagements, such as 'His Majesty will be on the ground at 9 o'clock' and 'the men must be cautioned against the shameful irregularity in any soldier' (binding defective).

## **Condition Report**

3241. Binding: Lacking metal clasp. Joints are split and leather is peeling around the extremities. The upper cover has an indistinct ink name possibly Capt'n Falinces, there are also some jottings or calculation to the left of this. The lower cover has some score marks and is nearly detached. The binding is relatively tight and no stubs are present so it is likely to be complete, but it is not paginated and there may be a quire missing at the end - difficult to establish.

Internally: The first and last pages are a little soiled and stained but otherwise the leaves are in good condition commensurate with age.
