An early 20th century nickel plated Goliath pocket watch with MM & Co patent light feature, the enamel dial with black Roman numerals, subsidiary seconds and detailed 'Vickery 181 & 183 Regent St London' above 'MM & Co Patent', case diameter 7.5cm, within a leather mounted battery case (faults), together with a leather cased Goliath travelling timepiece, the enamel dial detailed 'J.C. Vickery to their Majesties... 8 days', dial diameter 12.2cm, and a Juvenia leather cased travelling timepiece (faults).

Condition Report

1098. Torch watch - there are a few faint hairlines running diagonally from 12 o'clock to 7 o'clock. Otherwise watch in generally good order with typical wear and scratches to case. It winds and adjusts smoothly and is currently working but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch.

Large travel timepiece - dial is in very good clean condition. There is obviously only part of the case present. It is missing its winder so cannot tell you if it works, but when you give it a shake, the balance is free and ticks away nicely for a period.
