A pair of clear glass table lamp bases, early 20th century, each leaf moulded sconce and drip pan above a tall slender tapering base, height 64cm (converted for electricity), together with a Spanish plate mounted glass jug, the hinged lid in the form of a boar's head, the handle in the form of a boar's tail, height 36cm.

Condition Report

1615. Table lamp bases - both drip trays have chips to interior rims, one is also cracked. One has slightly unevenly moulded feet, with a few chips. Otherwise ok.

Jug - some minor nibbles to the glass interior rim, otherwise in good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs.
