LOT 1010

A Turkish Market tortoiseshell veneered quadruple cased keywind pocket watch, the gilt fusee movement with a verge escapement, detailed to the back plate 'Edwd Prior, London, 40327', the signed enamelled dial with Turkish hour markers, case diameter 4.3cm, the second inner case decorated with engraved borders, the third inner case with tortoiseshell covered exterior, the outer hunting travelling case with floral engraved decoration, outer case diameter 7cm, with a key (the suspension bow to the pocket watch lacking).

Estimate: £300 - £500

Condition Report

1010. Watch and case in generally good order commensurate with age.

Numerous small dents to sides of outer case and some minor wear to engraving. Hinge is good.

Tortoiseshell inner case in generally good order with a few small splits to the tortoiseshell on the front and back and some minor silver inlay missing. Also typical surface scratches and wear. Hinge is good.

Other inner case in good clean order with typical light surface scratches and wear. Hinge is good.

Watch itself is not currently in working order. The case has typical light wear and scratches and missing its bow surmount. Enamel dial has a hairline from centre to 2/3 o'clock and some surface scratches, otherwise ok.

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
