Condition Report

501. The brooch pin fitting to the back is a later carefully added alteration. The back of the piece has the facility to receive two clasp tongues. The back of the border of the mount has one or two dents. The shell cameo is in good condition. The surrounding setting is also in good condition. Overall an attractive piece. Total weight 33g.
