## LOT 520

A gold and diamond five stone ring, claw set with a row of circular cut diamonds graduating to the centre with rose cut diamond set points, detailed '18', ring size approx M1/2, with a case.

Estimate: £300 - £500

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## Condition Report

520. Colour: approx J on average. Clarity: VS2-SI1 on average. There are a few internal inclusions to the old cut diamonds which are generally fairly well matched. There is a mixture of cuts to the diamond points. Some of the claws have been re-tipped in the past. There is some wear visible to the sides of the setting. Some claws would benefit from closing to make the diamonds more secure. Total diamond weight approx 1.80-2.00ct. Suggested age - circa 1900. Weight 3.1g.

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
