A pair of Royal Worcester Arab water carrier figures, circa 1887 and 1888, modelled after Hadley, as a man and woman in traditional dress, each resting an amphora on a stone pillar, raised on naturalistic circular bases, impressed and puce printed factory marks to bases with model numbers '1126' and '1127', height 45cm (restoration).

Estimate: £1,000 - £1,500

Condition Report

1458. Man - large amount of restoration to lower middle section of robes to front and back, including lower half of bamboo cane and some residue spraying to pillar and some sections of gilt decoration to hen re-painted. All professionally executed.

Woman - in good condition overall, no chips, cracks or repairs. Some wear to gilded detail on urn.
