A small collection of Chinese porcelain, 18th century and later, including two export plates, an export bowl, two vases and a stem cup, together with a Chinese famille verte plate, Kangxi period, diameter 22.8cm, and a famille rose export saucer, painted with figures in a landscape, diameter 13.5cm (some faults).

Estimate: £80 - £120

Condition Report

1036. Stem cup - good condition with no chips, cracks or repairs.

Export bowl - star crack to base otherwise good order.

Blue and White plate - good condition with no chips, cracks or repairs.

Famille Verte Plate - section of rim (12cm x 5cm broken out and re-glued, another hairline to rim and two rim chips.

Blue & White Plate (landscape) - broken in half and re-glued.

Blue and White Tapering Vase - restored rim otherwise in good order.

Lotus & Tendril Decorated Blue & White Vase - crack to neck and two minor chips to rim.

Small Ginger Jar and Cover - good condition with no chips, cracks or repairs. Typical light surface scratches to glaze.

Small Blue & White Bowl - cracked and chips to rim

Provincial Bowl - some wear to glaze, otherwise good condition.

Circular Box Lid - good condition with no chips, cracks or repairs. The base of the box does not match the cover as a little bit smaller, good condition.

Famille Rose Saucer - cracked and minor wear to enamels.
