A George III oak dresser, the plate rack with a pierced fretwork frieze, the base fitted with two drawers above two arched panel doors, on stile supports, height 185cm, width 145cm, depth 50cm.

Estimate: £300 - £500

Condition Report

2002. To start with, the plate rack has been altered and restored in the late 19th/early 20th century and has some areas of woodworm. The top surface of the base has some woodworm and some cracks but all appears to be original and of good colour.

The drawers have later fitted handles and the right drawer has a few minor faults and repairs to the front. The drawer runners have been replaced. The right-hand cupboard has a crack through the panel and the handles and locks have been replaced at a later date. The rear legs appear to have been replaced, as the originals would have deteriorated over time. Generally, nicely pegged joints throughout and genuine ongoing repairs.
