A 17th century and later oak console table, the rectangular top above a frieze with carved linenfold decoration, raised on turned and baluster carved supports united by an undertier, height 77cm, width 134cm, depth 45cm (alterations).

### Condition Report

2040. Both of the legs appear to be period and are nicely peg jointed to both side friezes and pot shelf rails. Sections of the rear supports are later spliced in. How much of the rest of it is original is quite hard to say. The pot shelf looks like it could be 17th century, the top perhaps not of the same period, but certainly some old elements throughout. Drawer runners are later and some overall deterioration to areas, with old woodworm, chips and damage.
