Condition Report

1828. Overall light wear, marks as you might expect.

additional comments

1828. Was part of a large collection of coins built up throughout the 1960's, described when brought to us as bronze age ring money adornment. Although recent research suggests some of these similar items are indeed 19th century African, which is why we are only saying probably Bronze Age. We have no more provenance. Similar rings have gone through some of the more prominent coins and antiquities auctions over the 20 years described as bronze age, although we cannot prove this piece to be one way or the other.
