A Chinese blue and white porcelain vase, Kangxi period, of baluster form, painted with a design of lotus flowerheads and scrolling leafy tendrils beneath an applied metal rim, underglaze blue double ring to base, height 26cm (crack to body).

Estimate: £200 - £300

Condition Report

1019. Applied metal rim so presume porcelain rim may have some chips/damage. There is an approx 15cm hairline crack to body running diagonally. There is also a hairline crack which runs horizontally around the neck/shoulder of the vase, this crack is approx 14cm in length. Otherwise generally good condition with no other crack or repairs.
