Condition Report

605. Locket � the interior glazing to the front of the locket is missing. The hinge is in good condition. The back is engraved with a monogram and the enamelling at the front is a bit scratched particularly to the central section. Gold chain � a little dented in places and one link is rather weak. The inner links are slightly dislodged in places and the boltring pin is out of alignment and would be unreliable for safety. One larger oval ring of the chain lacking.

Neckchain - weight 6.1g.

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
