A Chinese famille verte enameled biscuit porcelain figure of Guandi, late Qing dynasty, the god of war modelled seated on his throne, decorated in green, yellow and aubergine glaze, height 23.5cm (minor faults), together with wood table lamp stand.

Condition Report

1106. Generally good condition. He has lost a finger and end of thumb to his left hand but otherwise no other significant damage or repairs. He would benefit from a clean as he is a bit dirty and there is a small section of metal rattling around inside the figure, which was part of the lamp fitting.
