Samuel Lewis - 'A Topographical Dictionary of Scotland', folding engraved map in six parts with near period hand-colouring, published by Lewis circa 1851, each part overall 69cm x 64.5cm, within cloth covered boards with gilt titles.

Condition Report

91. All parts have some spotting, minor age toning and offsetting. They also have small splits at the central folds and some old creasing. Part V has slightly heavier creasing and several very small holes from insect damage, the largest being 4 holes approx 4mm in diameter. The binding is soiled, bumped and chipped to head and foot of spine.
