A pair of green glass lustres, late 19th/early 20th century, each bulbous shaped top enamelled and gilded with floral garlands and scrollwork, hung with two tiers of cut drops, raised on knopped stems and circular feet, height 36cm (some faults to drops).

Condition Report

1609. The body of each lustre is overall in good condition with no cracks, chips or repairs. The gilding and enamelling on each is rubbed and worn. There are losses, faults and damages to the drops, at least a few missing and one lustre is completely missing one hole and subsequently a hook where one drop should be hanging.
