An Edwardian silver sugar caster of urn form with embossed ram's mask and swag decoration, on a circular foot and square base, Birmingham 1904 by Henry Matthews, height 19cm, together with two Chinese silver figure groups by Wang Hing, modelled as a sedan chair and rickshaw, a plated and enamel 'Just a Thimblefull' measure, leather cased, a silver and enamel rouge pot (chipped), a silver circular photograph frame, two spoons and a model horse.

Condition Report

313. Please note, this condition report is for one specific item in the Lot, and is NOT for the whole Lot. Sugar Caster - The square base is slightly bent/misshapen. The circular wreath to foot has a 2cm vertical split ot it. Few very minor dents to body and typical surface wear to highpoints and typical light rubbing to hallmarks. No glass liner. Caster individually weights 222g.
