530. The carbuncle garnets are generally in good condition. There is an acid test mark to the back of the cross. The suspension loop at the top of the cross is slightly open and shows evidence of an old repair. There are traces of the French eagle the shead gold mark at the top of the cross. There are a few old shallow dents at the back. The gold neckchain looks rather grubby and would benefit from professional cleaning. Cross the weight 7.9g. Chain to weight 5.6g.
