### **Condition Report**

539. The roller hook to the clasp is a later replacement. There is a chip to the glass at the back of the locket. The enamel has one or two very minor surface marks which are hardly noticeable. One half-pearl is chipped and damaged and some of the other half-pearls are a little grey. Otherwise the brooch is in generally good condition. Weight 19.2g.
