An Edwardian Arts and Crafts oak framed armchair, designed by G.M. Ellwood for J.S. Henry, upholstered in a foliate patterned damask, the winged sides and front seat rail carved in relief with acorn and oak leaf roundels, the shaped armrests on downswept supports, raised on block legs united by stretchers, height 116cm, width 69cm, depth 67cm.

Estimate: £600 - £900

Condition Report

4034. Both of the rear legs are made of walnut and have some minor woodworm. The rest of the oak frames seems ok and is in generally good order, having one slightly loose arm joint and some overall light scuffs and marks. The bottom caps on the ends of the legs could possibly be later but they have been replaced very well if they are. The upholstery is in good clean condition with just a few minor marks.
