## Condition Report

4084. The main body of the container has one small indentation to the side and the flared base is slightly misshapen on one side. The lid is very slightly creased around the spoon slot and very slightly dented to edge. The spoon is in good order and has similar minor surface scuffs and fine scratches to the surface, as does the jar and cover. There is no real liner replacement, just a moulded glass beaker.
