A group of glass decanters and stoppers, 19th century and later, including a pair of triple ring neck decanters and stoppers with facet cut decoration, height 24.5cm, and a silver mounted example, London 1934 by Mappin & Webb.

Estimate: £50 - £70

Condition Report

1612. Pair of triple ring neck - early 19th century. Decanter 1 in good condition, stopper has a repaired chip to underside and small chip to end of stopper. Decanter 2 in good condition, minor chips to edge of stopper.
Ewer decanter - 20th century. Cloudy but good condition.
Silver collar decanter - 20th century. Body in good condition with re-glued chip to corner of stopper.
Sherry decanter with ogee body - early 20th century. Good condition but cloudy.
Short decanter and stopper - mid-20th century. Good condition, but a bit dirty.
Vertical slice cut decanter - circa 1900. Dirty to base interior, would require a good clean, otherwise good condition.
