A 'Vienna' porcelain blue ground potpourri vase and cover, early 20th century, the flattened bulbous body painted by F. Michel, signed, with a titled scene of the Judgement of Paris opposing a titled scene of Clio, the Muse of History, against detailed gilded grounds, raised on a waisted stemmed oval foot and pedestal base beneath the pierced rim, the cover with acanthus knob, blue printed shield mark to base, height 35.5cm (cover repaired).

Estimate: £150 - £250

Condition Report

1410. Vase - Clio scene, one figure has pinhead sized chip/bruise to an eye, otherwise all in good condition with no restoration. Gilding and enamels strong and bright with no wear.

Cover - one small and one larger piece of cover broken away and visibly glued back with associated haircrack.

Finial re-stuck and with metal fixing, also with glued chips and minor loss.
