A mid-Victorian rosewood rectangular stool, the needlework seat above a carved frieze, raised on cabriole legs and brass castors, height 42cm, width 92cm, depth 58cm.

Condition Report

2185. The woolwork is almost certainly original, but has much wear and some loss to the wool. The upholstery is stuffed in what is probably the original horse hair and further padding. The webbing is all quite sound still. The frame has some overall minor surface wear and scuffs fairly commensurate with its age. The joints on three of the legs are slightly loose, one of them a little more than the others, but still fairly structurally sound.
