A mid-19th century Continental silver mounted mammoth tooth rectangular snuff box, the hinged lid and sides with cast foliate borders, unmarked, length 8cm.

Condition Report

405. There is a small repair to the mammoth tooth top panel in the front right corner and some glue residue (greenish) to this corner and up the right hand edge of the top panel.

The base panel has a crack across it from front to back, otherwise the panels are in generally good order with a few other natural shrinkage hairlines/cracks.

The silver mounts appear to be in fairly good order with typical light surface wear, particularly to highpoints. No significant damage, but interior is a bit dirty and dusty. No hallmarks.
