1099. The rim of the cover has been restored with overpainting covering approx 8.5cm x 3cm, otherwise cover appears to be in good order.

The jar is essentially in good condition with no significant damage or repairs. There are a few very minor chips to high points of moulding and the black enamelled ground is flaking in numerous places from top to bottom.
